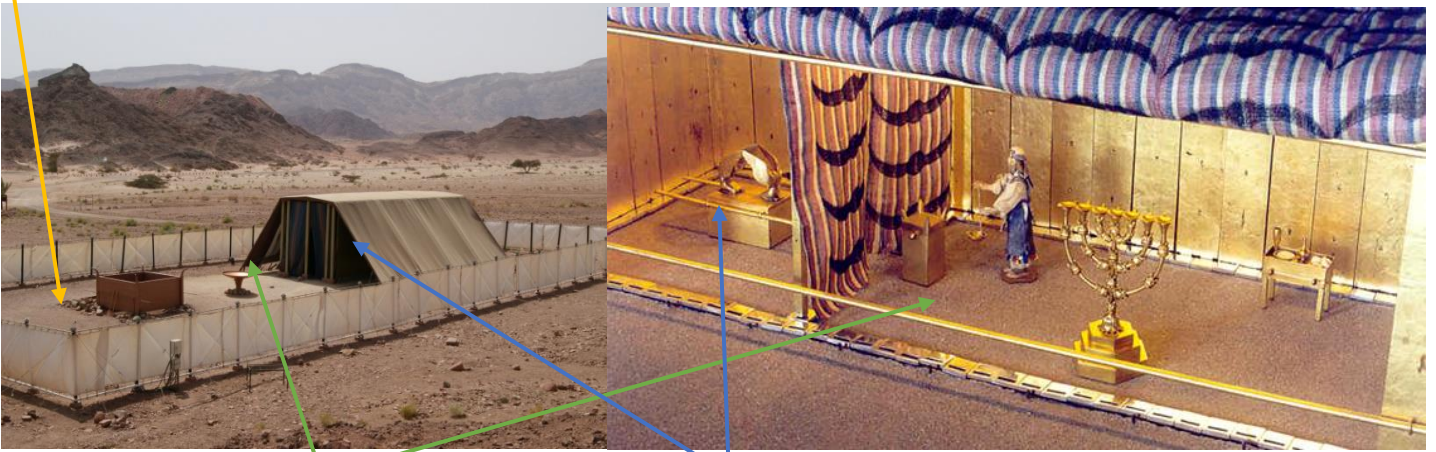

The Courtyard:

Contains the Altar of Burnt Offering (Crucifixion), and the Laver (Baptism).

Justification

The Holy Place:

Contains the Altar of Incense (Prayer), the Candlestick (Faith), and the Table of Shewbread (Word of God).

The Most Holy Place, Holy of Holies:

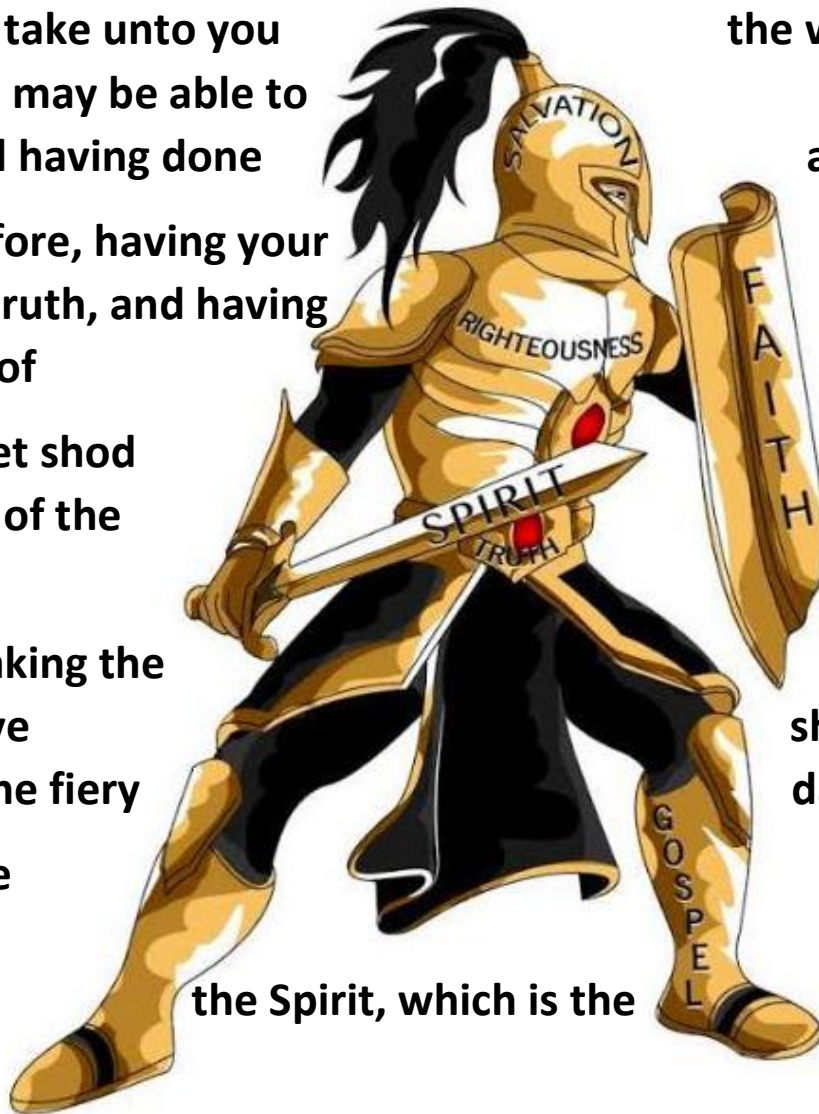

Ten Commandments

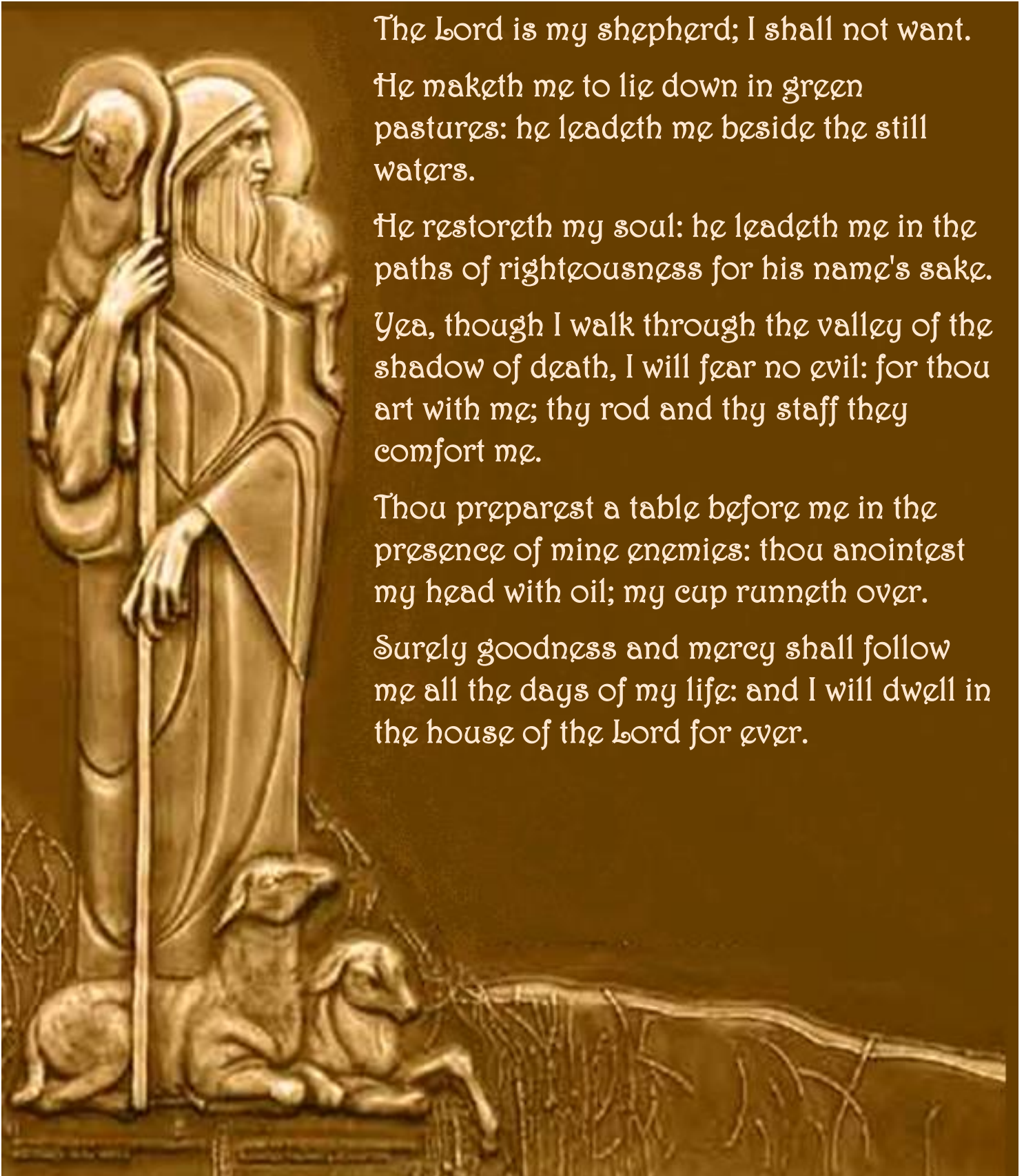

The Seven Churches of Revelation

Ephesus (31-100)

Labored for God, not fainted, but left first love. The apostolic church.

Smyrna (100-313)

Suffered persecution, tribulation, and poverty. No reprimand for Smyrna.

Pergamos (313-538)

Corruption, link between church and state, dwell where "Satan's seat is."

Thyatira (538-1299)

Fatal compromises and false prophets, civil papal authority, dark ages.

Sardis (1299-1449)


A "dead" church. Command to strengthen that which remains and is "ready to die."

Philadelphia (1449-1844)


Church revival. Has "a little strength," has kept God's Word and not denied Him.

Laodicea (1844-present)

Lukewarm church. God spits them out. Rich, blind to spiritual needs.

 - Plea for justice
 - Martyrdom and persecution
6. **EARTHQUAKE, SIGNS IN HEAVEN**
 - Violent natural disasters
 - Troublesome times
7. **SILENCE IN HEAVEN**
 - Silence for a “half hour”
 - Jesus’ Second Coming
